



## CSPG Undergraduate Awards

**Description:** Three awards in the amount of \$1000 each will be awarded across Canada by region plus one award of \$1000 not restricted by region.

Regions are defined as follows

1. Atlantic & Quebec Universities
2. Central / Ontario Universities
3. Western Universities

**Purpose:** To provide recognition to up and coming Geology or Earth Science students who demonstrate a keen interest and flair for geology, particularly as it pertains to softrock geology and oil and gas exploration and development.

**Eligibility:** Candidates for this award must be:

- Enrolled fulltime in an undergraduate Geology or Earth Science degree program at a Canadian University
- In either the 3rd or 4th year of their program
- A student member of the CSPG at the time of application—free student membership is available through [cspg.org](http://cspg.org)

**Application Details:**

- Candidates must submit a 400 - 600 word statement on their interest in soft rock and/or petroleum geoscience, and its importance to Canadian society. Additionally, the award committee would like to see evidence of this interest, such as (but not limited to) evidence of volunteer work, summer/term employment, course and thesis choices, research for professors, etc
- Candidates must include the contact information for one of their recent professors who feels the candidate shows potential in soft rock and/or petroleum geology. Applications must include the professor's name, title, university, phone number and email address. A representative of CSPG University Outreach committee may contact the professor. Please ensure the application has his or her support prior to submission.
- Candidates should include a copy of their resume and most recent transcript (unofficial), highlighting grades in any soft rock or petroleum geology related courses. These could include, but are not limited to: clastic or carbonate sedimentology, stratigraphy, paleontology, micropaleontology, ichnology, structural geology, basin analysis, field school, and geophysics.
- Candidates must include their CSPG student membership number.
- Applications must be submitted as a .pdf by email to [membership@cspg.org](mailto:membership@cspg.org)

### Application deadline is February 28th, 2022

Candidates must submit original, signed copies of their application package by email January 31st, 2021. The committee will review the submissions and contact the awardees. CSPG Undergraduate Award winners will have their names published on the CSPG website.
